NEW COVID-19 REGULATIONS

Effective 12/6/20

In compliance with the State's Regional Stay at Home Order, Hotels, Lodging and Short Term Rentals cannot accept or honor out-of-state reservations for non-essential travel, unless the reservation is for at least the minimum time period required for quarantine and the persons identified in the reservation will quarantine in the hotel or lodging entity until after that time period has expired. Hot tubs must also be closed.

The following requirements must be met in compliance with the Temporary Targeted Safer at Home Health Officer Order issued on November 28, 2020. These temporary measures are effective from 12:01 AM (PST) on November 30, 2020 until further notice: o Hotels, lodging and short-term rentals must close outdoor pools that are used by multiple households except for regulated lap swimming (one swimmer per lane).

In compliance with the State's Regional Stay at Home Order, issued December 3, 2020 and effective on December 6, 2020 at 12:59PM (PST) through until further notice, all hotels, lodging and short-term rentals cannot accept or honor out-of-state reservations for non-essential travel, unless the reservation is for at least the minimum time period required for quarantine and the persons identified in the reservation will quarantine in the hotel or lodging entity until after that time period has expired. When the Regional Stay at Home order is in effect, hotels and lodging can only offer accommodation for COVID-19 mitigation and containment measures, treatment measures, accommodation for essential workers, or providing housing solutions, including measures to protect homeless populations.

In compliance with HEALTH OFFICER ORDER FOR CONTROL OF COVID-19: TIER 1 SUBSTANTIAL SURGE RESPONSE issued November 28, 2020, all employees must wear face coverings at all times except when working alone in private offices with closed doors or when eating or drinking.
